HISTORY

The Terri Lynne Lokoff Child Care Foundation (TLLCCF) was founded in August 1987 by Fred and Kay Lokoff to honor the memory of their daughter Terri, who died tragically in a car accident. Terri had a Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education and worked as a child care teacher. She had an extraordinary sense of devotion and love for her work and strongly felt the need for increased and improved child care.

The TLLCCF is a public non-profit 501 (c) (3) foundation that continues Terri's efforts by supporting non-sectarian, non-profit child care programs dedicated to excellence. Our funds have benefited tens of thousands of children, many programs, providers and educational scholarships at outstanding child care agencies and institutions. We are committed to ensuring the availability of quality child care for all children and families.

A Message from the Founder & the President...

Dear Friends,

Calendar year 2008 marked the beginning of a transition for the Terri Lynne Lokoff Child Care Foundation (TLLCCF). On the surface it may not look much different. Behind the scenes the Foundation is preparing to serve another generation of young children, child care teachers and other constituents that this Foundation supports and by whom it is supported.

During 2008 and with the help of the William Penn Foundation, the TLLCCF began a consultation organized by the Nonprofit Center at LaSalle University. Initial work included a series of interviews and focus groups to help the Foundation set its priorities. The consultation resulted in a board consensus that the TLLCCF should focus on its programs that are unique. Thus National Child Care Teachers Awards™ and Lois B. Cohan Museums to Go will become growth areas of the Foundation while the Child Care Center Enhancement Grants will continue in its current form. Additional consultation in 2009 will concentrate on a development plan.

There were highs and there were lows this past year. During 2008 the Foundation marked the passing of long-time friends and supporters Lois Cohan and Sheila Chefetz. It is another sign of transition when we begin to lose those who have been with us since the beginning. Although gone, they are not forgotten as each left a mark on this organization.

The Cohan family directed donations to the Foundation in Lois' name and added to them to create an endowment for the newly renamed Lois B. Cohan Museums to Go program. Further, family guarantees ensured the continuation of this important program under a five-year commitment beginning in 2009. In addition, a specific grant from the SEI Cares Fund allowed us to grow the program from 10 centers to 23 centers in 2008. The support of the Cohan family plus the described grant resulted in over 1,500 contacts between mostly at-risk children and high-quality arts, cultural and learning experiences to which the children may not have otherwise been exposed during this past year. As we look forward, the template created in Philadelphia can serve as a model to expand Lois B. Cohan Museums to Go to additional cities as early as 2010 as we seek funding sources in other geographic areas.

The Terri Lynne Lokoff/Children's TYLENOL® National Child Care Teacher Awards™ honored 52 outstanding child care teachers from across the country. During 2008 the groundwork was laid to make the program international by including teachers on overseas U. S. Military bases as part of the competition. We have heard from past winners that have told us they felt empowered by the experience and have expanded their own horizons on to become community advocates for giving all children the opportunity for the right start in life. Our 2009 goal is to find additional national sponsorship to join title sponsor, Children's TYLENOL®, in support of this program and this organization. Look for the 2010 National Child Care Teacher Awards™ to be held at the Please Touch Museum in early spring. Watch our new electronic newsletter for the formal announcement.

Child Care Center Enhancement Grants continued to improve quality in southeastern Pennsylvania. Thirty-one centers were selected to receive awards in 2008. In a sign of the times, one center ceased operation during year, another was sold to a for-profit entity and a third was unable to secure additional financing to complete its project. Grant funding given to these three entities was returned. Twenty-eight centers successfully utilized their grants.



In 2009 we will continue to add strategic skills and new energy to our board of directors. We will reshape our governance and articulate our goals more clearly. We will welcome new faces, new ideas and new attitudes. We will continue to make America better by improving early care and education.

The Terri Lynne Lokoff/Children's TYLENOL® National Child Care Teacher Awards™ was created to recognize and raise the status and visibility of high-quality child care and child care teachers. From 1994 to 2008, the Foundation awarded 482 child care teachers with the prestigious Terri Lynne Lokoff/Children's TYLENOL® National Child Care Teacher Award™. The Helene Marks Award as the National Child Care Teacher of the Year was presented to one of the teachers from among the recipients who stood out as the best among the 52 recipients and was awarded an additional grant of \$1,000.

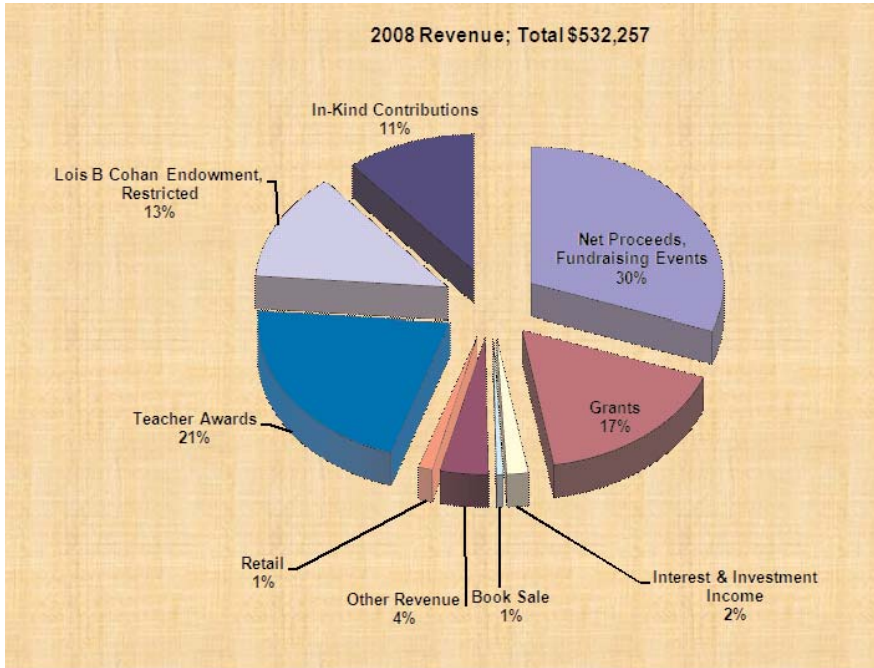

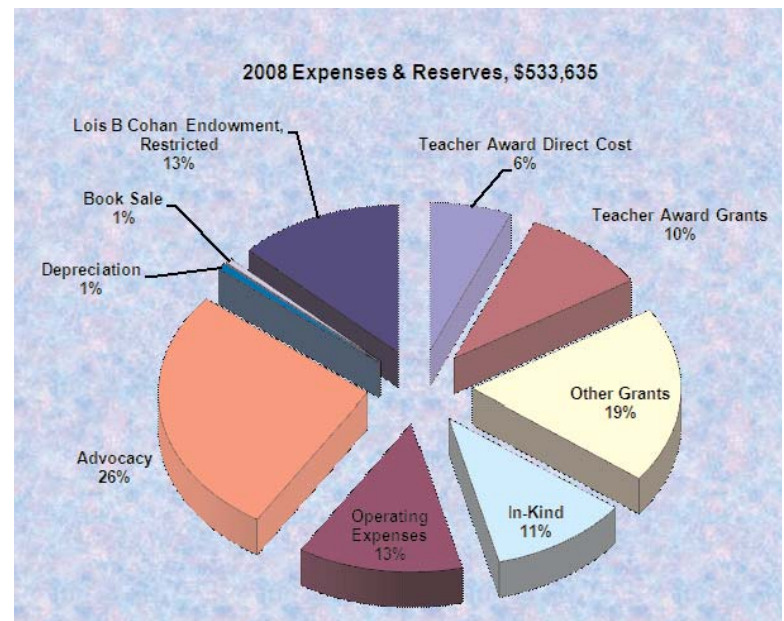
Summary of Operations 2008



Children who attend high-quality child care programs start kindergarten ready to learn. They learn many skills and social behaviors from interacting with peers, such as sharing, respecting others, dealing with disappointment, being a gracious winner, and other social behaviors.

A child's preschool years are the most critical to their intellectual development. A child's vocabulary is determined by words filtered through the brain by the age of three. Foundations for math and logic are set by the age of four. Emotional stability is largely dependent on brain development in the first two years.

The photos on this page are from the TLLCCF's Lois B. Cohan Museums to Go program (MTG). Through MTG the children experience firsthand, high quality programs from outstanding local area museums and cultural programs. The programs are brought into the classroom where the children interact with an educational guide from the museums who presents the age-appropriate program to the class. MTG provides children with an opportunity they might not otherwise experience.
